





ISCC offers different certification schemes





- Used to demonstrate compliance with the regulated **EU RED II sustainability criteria**
- ISCC is recognized by the EU COM for **RFNBO, RCF (since 2024) and biofuel (since 2010)** certification under RED II & RED III
- Fuel producers need to be certified by a voluntary scheme to be able to fulfil **quota obligations**

Traceability must be ensured throughout the whole supply chain: RFNBO supply chain

Union database (UDB) for liquid & gaseous transport fuels

*The Commission shall ensure that a Union database is put in place to enable the **tracing of liquid and gaseous transport fuels** that are eligible for being counted towards the [biofuel quota].*


Art. 28 (2) RED II

- Union Database (UDB) aims to **reduce the risk of fraud**, particularly in high-risk supply chains
- Database will be applicable for **all supply chain elements**; information on **sustainability and GHG saving characteristics** for transactions must be provided by system users
- The details of the **UDB implementation** will be announced once confirmed

Targets for transport within RED III

-  Binding sub-target for **RFNBO of 1 % of transport energy consumption**
-  Combined sub-target for advanced **biofuels and RFNBOs of 5.5 % of transport energy consumption**
-  Overall target **29 % (2030) of energy in transport must be from renewable sources**
